COUNT I - AGGRAVATED BATTERY

In that said defendant, in committing a battery, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-3, and while on or about public property, being the Perry County Jail, knowingly caused bodily harm to Adam T. Williams, in that he grabbed Adam T. Williams by the head and slammed it into a cell wall,

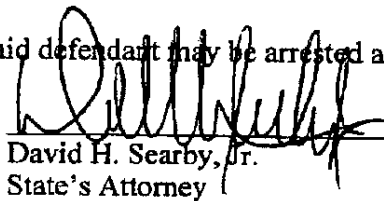
Class 3 Felony [pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/12-3.05(h)]

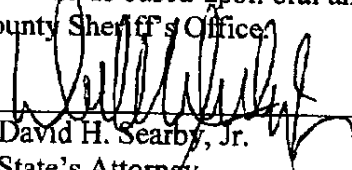
Class 3 Felony [pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/12-3.05(h)]

Said State's Attorney requests that said defendant may be arrested and dealt with according to law.

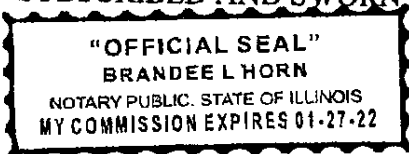


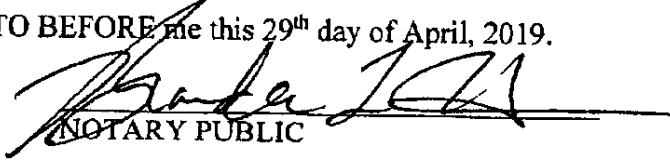

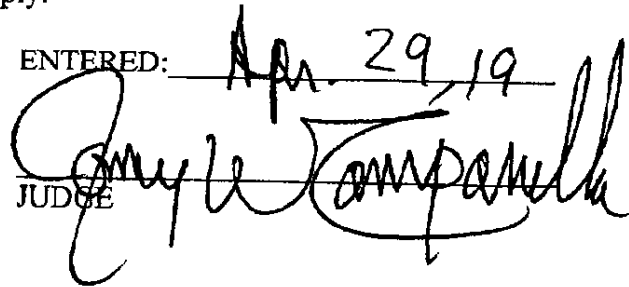
