## **Volunteers Needed for Murphysboro Sidewalk Audit**

Your input will help community leaders prioritize sidewalk improvements and make the streets safer for all residents.

The morning will kick-off with a free breakfast for volunteers and opening remarks from Mayor Stephens and event organizers. Community members who step forward to help will be given an Apple City Walkability Squad t-shirt and \$10 in farmers market dollars that can be used to purchase items at the Murphysboro Farmers Market, a walkable destination in town.
